Throw away paper towels, pick up after yourself and do not put things into the toilets to clog them up.






Health issues

Compare and contrast daily cost

- Paper Towels coast about \$1,460 or more to maintain, whereas Dyson Airblade Dryers cost about \$40-\$50 a year.
- Touchless Sink faucets, \$240.79
- Manual flush toilet, cost an average of \$348 or less,
 but with installation it could cost up to \$800
- Shatter and scratch proof mirrors could cost up to \$100 or more for a 3" by 3" mirror, the bigger the more it costs.



Options to reduces cost

- Switch to Dyson Airblade Dryers (won't catch on fire if students put paper in them)
- Stay with manual toilets, with the handles
- Get mirrors that are scratch and shatter resistant.
- Get the whole school to get responsibility in keeping the bathrooms clean.
